

SEATTLE IN PROGRESS PRIVACY POLICY

The Seattle in Progress Privacy Policy (“**Privacy Policy**”) governs your use of the SiP Site, and it is meant to be read in conjunction with the SiP Terms of Use available here. Capitalized terms may be defined herein or in the Terms of Use. By accessing the SiP Site, You agree to this Privacy Policy and the Terms of Use.

A. What information does the SiP obtain and how is it used?

User Provided Information. SiP obtains information you provide when you register with SiP (the “**User Provided Information**”). Registration with us is optional. When you register with us you generally provide: (a) your name; (b) email address; (c) information you may provide us if you ask for help; and (d) credit card information for purchase. Please note that the credit card information is NEVER SEEN BY SiP. Instead, a third party credit card processor handles that information and payment, and the entire transaction is handled by such third party.

Automatically Collected Information. In addition, we may collect information automatically, such as the type of device you use, the IP address of your device, your operating system, the type of internet browser you use, and information about the way you use the SiP Site (the “**Automatically Collected Information**”). See the “Automatic Data Collection and Advertising” section for examples.

B. Does the Licensed Application collect precise real-time location information?

The Licensed Application does collect precise information about the location of your device. We use your location information to center the map on your current location. We share this information with Google through our use of Google Maps.

C. Do third parties see or have access to information obtained by SiP?

Yes. We will share your information with third parties only in the ways that are described in this privacy statement.

We may disclose User Provided and Automatically Collected Information:

- As required by law, such as to comply with a subpoena, or similar legal process;
- When we believe, in good faith, that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request; and
- To trusted service providers who work on our behalf, do not have an independent use of the information we disclose to them, and have agreed to adhere to the rules set forth in this Privacy Policy.

D. Automatic Data Collection and Advertising

We may work with analytics companies to help us understand how the SiP Site is being used, such as frequency and duration of usage. We do not work with advertisers, and we will not give or sell your information to third parties for advertising purposes.

E. Children

We do not use the SiP Site to knowingly solicit data from children under the age of 13. The SiP Site is not intended to be used by children and we do not market use of the SiP Site to children.

F. Security

We are concerned about safeguarding the confidentiality of your information. We provide electronic and procedural safeguards to protect the information that we process and maintain. For example, we limit access of this information to authorized employees and contractors who need to know that information in order to operate, develop, or improve the SiP Site. Please be aware that, although we endeavor to provide reasonable security for information we process and maintain, no security system can prevent all potential security breaches.

G. Changes

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time for any reason at SiP's sole discretion. Each time you use the site, you agree to any changes (which will be tracked at the top of this page). We may notify you of any changes to the Privacy Policy via email, text message, a click through agreement when opening, or at the conclusion of a software upgrade.

H. Your Consent

We reiterate that by using the SiP Site, you agree to this Privacy Policy and specifically consent to our processing of User Provided and Automatically Collected Information as set forth in this Privacy Policy now and as amended. "Processing" means using cookies on a computer or mobile or other hand held device or using or touching information in any way, including without limitation, collecting, storing, deleting, using, combining and disclosing information, all of which activities will take place in the United States. If you reside outside of the United States, your information will be transferred to the United States as well as processed and stored in the United States under applicable privacy standards. By using the Licensed Application, you consent to such transferring and processing in the United States.
